Project Purpose


To comply with the conditions of the City's Modified Consent Decree with the U.S. EPA and MDE

- To repair a sewer system that is up to 100 years old
- To prioritize pipe rehabilitation work through condition assessment
- To improve sewage flows and pipe capacity
- To reduce/eliminate sewer overflows
- To eliminate street closures due to sewer pipe collapses
- To improve water quality in streams
- To prevent sewer back-ups into private property

Project History

The Sanitary Contract 1029 is a project with the purpose to assist in performing tasks and work other sanitary wastewater utilities contracts. The project is equipped with various asset items to take on the potential variety types of tasks.
