WC 1258 – Frederick Avenue & Vicinity & Lambeth & Kemble Roads Water Infrastructure Replacement Project Details

Project Background

DPW supplies drinking water to 1.8 million residents in the Metropolitan Area which encompasses 3,800 miles of water mains, 67,500 valves and 23,000 fire hydrants. DPW is responsible for maintaining the 1,500 miles of water mains located within city limits. The City must now replace its failing infrastructure, which includes water mains that are nearly 100 years old.

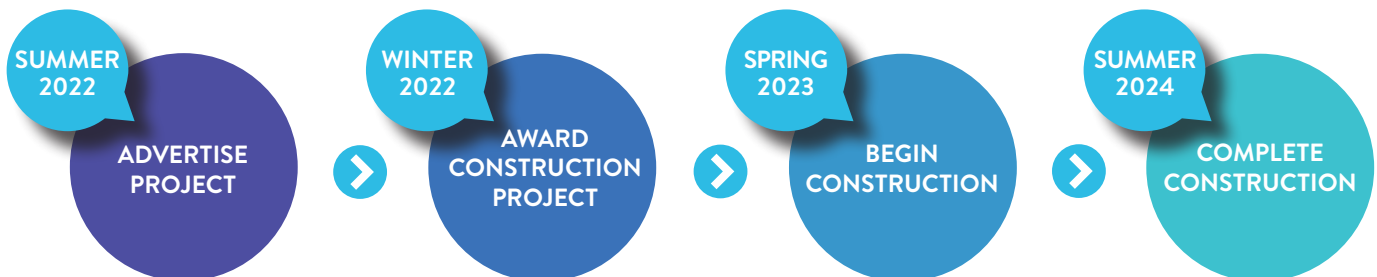
Project Purpose

- ▶ Improve water flows and water quality
- ▶ Reduce water service disruptions and costly repairs
- ▶ Minimize water main breaks
- ▶ Minimize street closures

Project Activities

- ▶ Provide temporary water service during construction
- ▶ Replace or repair **1.72 ±** miles of existing water mains, **1260** linear feet of water house connections and installation or replacement of **37** valves
- ▶ Install **21** new fire hydrants
- ▶ Replace existing valves within the project area
- ▶ Manage traffic and restore construction areas

Did you know?

Typically, homeowners' insurance policies do not cover repairs to exterior, underground water lines. *Financial assistance for exterior line repairs may be available through HomeServe USA or other warranty companies for qualifying homeowners.
