Who should apply?

Baltimore City residents ages 18 – 24, who have a high school diploma or GED, are unemployed or underemployed, and are not currently engaged in a job training or post-secondary education. *Driver's license preferred but not required.*

Why should I apply?

Baltimore City's water industry offers immediate entry-level job opportunities AND stable, well-paying careers with lots of potential for job growth and advancement.

What is YH2O?

YH2O is a six-month program which prepares young adults to be hired in the water industry in a variety of positions including:

- ◆ Utility Installer Apprentice
- ◆ Meter Reader/ Utility Specialist
- ◆ Operations Technician Apprentice
- ◆ Community Aide
- ◆ General Laborer
- ◆ Customer Care Analyst

Selected participants commit to:

- ◆ Attend classes Mondays and Tuesdays from 10:00am to 1:00pm beginning 2/25/2019 through 6/25/2019 at 101 West 24th Street.
- ◆ Register for YouthWorks to be placed in a five-week paid summer-internship with Baltimore City Department of Public Works. July 1st through August 2nd.

Participants receive:

- ◆ Basic job readiness training
- ◆ Worksite tours and job shadowing
- ◆ Opportunities to interview for full-time, entry level positions in the water industry
- ◆ Water Industry career exploration
- ◆ Connection with a career coach
