Below is the project construction status update

Work in Progress:

Sewer rehabilitation and manhole installation
 Sanitary pipe replacement and rehabilitation behind 2919 Overland Avenue.

Upcoming Work (March 2021)

- Sanitary sewer replacement and rehabilitation in conjunction with manhole installation and rehabilitation will continue behind 2919 Overland Avenue.
 - Heavy machinery will be used (construction noise is expected).
 - Sewer flow will be rediverted and managed with bypass pumps (some operational noise is expected) Work is expected to continue for approximately one month.
- Site restoration will be performed immediately after sanitary work is finalized.
- Armistead Gardens Park restoration with tree planting and grass seeding will start in the middle of March 2021.
