Project Purpose

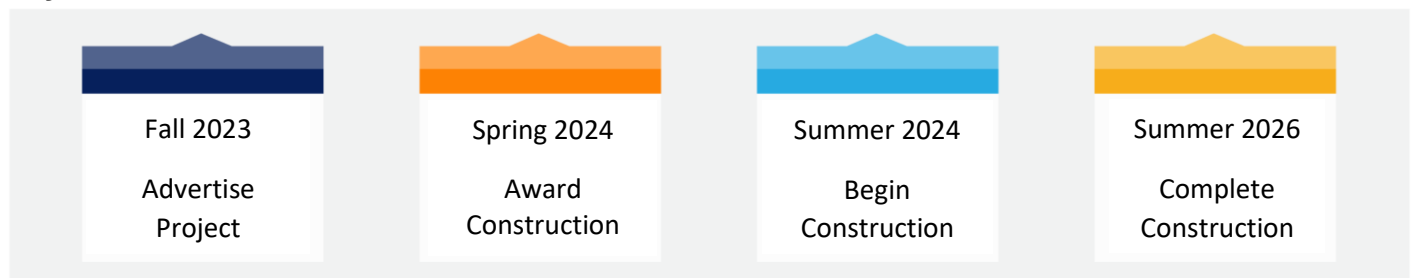
To comply with the conditions of the City's Modified Consent Decree with the U.S. EPA and MDE

- To repair a sewer system that is up to 100 years old
- To prioritize pipe rehabilitation work through condition assessment
- To improve sewage flows and pipe capacity
- To reduce/eliminate sewer overflows
- To eliminate street closures due to sewer pipe collapses
- To improve water quality in streams
- To prevent sewer back-ups into private property

Project History

The Sanitary Contract 1029 is a urgent needs project with the purpose to assist in performing tasks and work from other sanitary wastewater utilities contracts. The project is equipped with various asset items to take on the potential variety types of tasks. The various asset items includes CCTV inspections, pipeline cleaning, open cut replacement, CIPP lining, manhole rehabilitation, and etc.

- Fire Hydrant Permit has been approved
- ROW Permit has been approved and issued
- No work activities have been issued

Project Activities

- Rehabilitate sewers using cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) lining (~6000 LF)
- Light and Heavy cleaning and CCTV Inspection (~158,000 LF)
- Open cut replacement of sanitary sewer (~2700 LF)
- Repairment of the interior coating of manholes (~120 VF)
- Repairment of concrete sidewalk (~4500 SF)
- Manhole installations (~120 VLF)
