Below is the project construction status update. As of the writing of this memo the Project stands at 100% complete of the Contract’s scope of work. The Contractor is completing punch list items and major disturbances are not to be expected.

The purpose of this project is to:

- Repair the aging sewer system
- Prevent sewer back-ups into private property
- Reduce/eliminate sewer overflows
- Improve sewage flows and pipe capacity

Project Work has been completed

- **Restoration Work (Paving Repair and Soil Stabilization)**
 - York Road and Evesham Avenue (MTA Stop)

As we close out our Punchlist items for this project, a final point repair to the sewer at this location was finally completed. Final restoration to the Bee Pollinator Garden will not occur until the planting season later this Spring. DPW would like to thank Theresa Furnari of the Lake Evesham Community Association who along with other stakeholders who maintains the garden for their cooperation and coordination to affect this repair.
