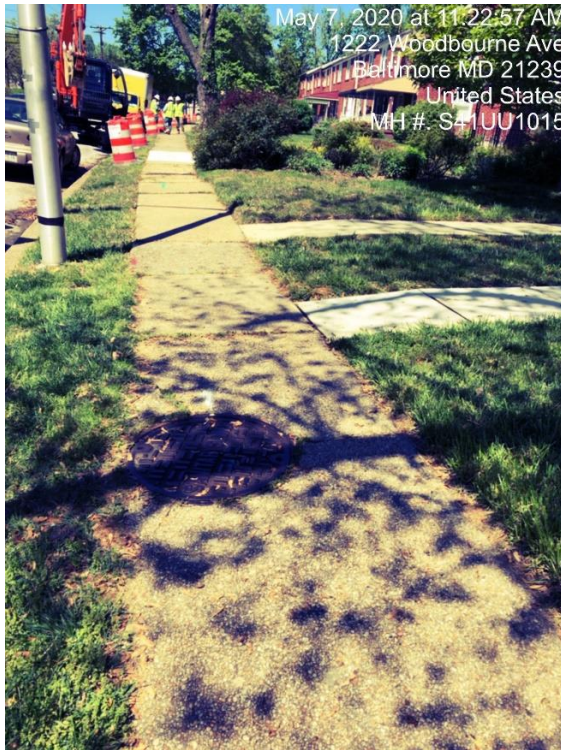
For this work residents may have access to sidewalks and/or driveways blocked and re-routed while work is in progress and during any concrete curing process.
