Below is the project construction status update

Work in Progress and Anticipated Work (April 27th through May 8th)

• **Mainline Replacement**

- 1500 Block of Sherwood Avenue – 8-inch Sewer Main Replacement
- 1200 Block Woodbourne Avenue– 8-inch Sewer Main Replacement
- Woodbourne Avenue from Northwood Dr. east to Purdue Avenue is closed to through traffic for the next 6 to 8 weeks for *Sewer Contract SC910*

For this work residents will be requested to limit their usage of the waste producing facilities, (ie. Toilet flushing, clothes washing, dish washers, etc.), during the active work hours from 8 AM to 3 PM. There will also be noise from excavation equipment and cutting tools and in some instances water usage may be limited.

• **Point Repair Work (Open Cut)**

- 501 Cedarcroft Avenue
- 5318 The Alameda
- 900 Block of Evesham Avenue
- 1600 Block Sherwood Avenue
- 1200 Block Woodbourne Avenue

For this work residents will be requested to limit their usage of the waste producing facilities, (ie. Toilet flushing, clothes washing, dish washers, etc.), during the active work hours from 8 AM to 3 PM. There will also be noise from excavation equipment and cutting tools and in some instances water usage may be limited.

• **Restoration (Paving)**

- 1300 Block of Kitmore Road
- 1600 Block of Sherwood Avenue

For this work residents may have access to sidewalks and/or driveways blocked and re-routed while work is in progress and during any concrete curing process.

• **Forestry (Tree Removal)**

- 1925 E. Belvedere Avenue
- 1600 Block of Sherwood Avenue

For this work residents may have access to sidewalks and/or driveways blocked and some chainsaw noise while work is in progress

Below is a picture of the road closure and construction activity from **Sewer Contract SC910** facing east on Woodbourne Avenue between Northwood Drive and Purdue Avenue. This activity is anticipated to continue for the next 6 to 8 weeks.
