To Whom It May Concern,

Below is the project construction status update. As of the writing of this memo the Project stands at 99% complete of the Contract's scope of work. The Contractor is currently completing punch list items for corrections to work already performed, but major disturbances for work under the project's scope are not to be expected.

The purpose of this project is to:

- Repair the aging sewer system
- Prevent sewer back-ups into private property
- Reduce/eliminate sewer overflows
- Improve sewage flows and pipe capacity

Work in Progress and Anticipated Work (December 2020)

- **Restoration Work (Paving Repair and Soil Stabilization)**

- Various Locations as needed

For this work residents may have access to sidewalks and/or driveways blocked and re-routed while work is in progress and during any concrete curing process. This work also involves the spreading of grass seed and straw to stabilize the disturbed soil and promote regrowth of the vegetation.
